A heavy-duty, high-alkaline, ready-to-use formula designed to remove old or failing exterior wood finishes, including oil-based and water-based stains, clear sealers, and semi-transparent coatings. Formulated with sodium hydroxide, this product effectively breaks down finishes and wood contaminants while the hose-end sprayer ensures convenient, even application over large areas.

Recommended Application

1	Preparation Protect surrounding vegetation and surfaces by pre-wetting or covering.
2	Connection Attach bottle directly to a garden hose and turn on water.
3	Application Turn dial to "ON" and spray evenly across wood surface.
4	Dwell Time Allow product to sit for 10–15 minutes, keeping surface wet. Do not allow product to dry on surface.
5	Agitate Use a stiff-bristle brush or deck scrubber as needed.
6	Rinse Rinse thoroughly using hose or pressure washer (low to moderate pressure).
7	Follow-Up Use a DeckGeneral wood brightener to neutralize the surface before staining or sealing.

Material Compatibility

Avoid strong oxidizing agents (i.e. bleach), strong reducing agents, strong bases (i.e. ammonia) and soft metals, such as aluminum.
